Abergele-Hafodunos Hall	An old yew on the lawn.
Betws-yn-Rhos	St Michael's church. A yew on the west side. Grid ref 907 735
Creuddyn Peninsula Woods	Grid ref SH 797 790 – a special area of conservation. Extent of yew here yet to be explored.
Dolgarrog	A yew of 15 ft girth was described in 1946, growing at the site where the church “used to be”.
Gorddinog	A ‘fine yew avenue’ was described in 1931 <i>Welsh Timber Trees</i>
Llandrillo-yn-Rhos	St Trillo's churchyard. 5 mature yews on the east and south east. Grid ref SH 832 806
Llanfihangel Glyn Myfyr	Churchyard yews- One NW, another in E corner. Grid ref SH 989 494
Pentrefoelas	Churchyard yews: ‘A number of mature yews on west side and one north’. Grid ref SH 873 516
