Axminster	A churchyard yew with a planting date of 1724.
Brentor	Ancient yew on tor.
Colyton	30 yews planted since 1818.
Coryton Park	A hedge planted in 1756.
Cruwys Morchard	Yew planted in SW corner of churchyard in 1792.
Hittesleigh	1906 – a fine churchyard yew
Lapford Manor	Lapford village is 7 miles NW of Crediton. Reference to a yew there is from December 2 nd 1687 : “An ancient yew tree stood among the ruins of Lapford Manor.” This from a book called <i>The Du Bury-Berry Family in General: The Benjamin Berry Family in Particular</i> by Mary E Quillen Honeywell, published in 1970.
Luppitt	16ft girth churchyard yew
Paignton	No information as to which churchyard in Paignton – a yew with a planting date of 1714.
Stoke Canon	No information, presumably churchyard.
Talaton	1946 – a yew with a girth of 9ft was recorded – probably churchyard.
Widcombe-in-the-Moor	A yew at this site apparently appears in an old painting of the church and churchyard.
Yealmpton	1946 – one or two yews, probably churchyard
