Bushbury	C19. The small village is sheltered on the east by a lofty hill covered with a provision of yew and other trees.
Croxden Abbey	A yew tree in the grounds of the Abbey appears in a B&W photo taken sometime between 1850 and 1920.
Knypersley	20 yews growing around a well O/S map 18 SJ 897 555
Longnor	Churchyard yew of about 15ft girth
