Craigmillar Castle

A ruined castle owned by Historic Scotland. Two twisted yews grow at the entrance to the castle. The Historic Scotland Education pack gives them an age of "more than 300 years."

Hawes Inn

The yew grows in the pub garden and is visible from the public footpath. Two web sites give an approximate age of 200 years to this yew. If the measurement is accurate (17ft 3ins) then it is likely to be considerably older.
