

1866: 'A tall vigorous tree' was described in the *Woolhope Transactions*.



The yew was measured in 2002 and photographed in 2009. Half of the bole is of dead wood and the leaning tree gives the impression that it might eventually become two fragment trees as a smaller section pulls away from the larger. Next to the tree a seat is dedicated to the memory of the cleric and diarist Francis Kilvert who is buried here.
