

2010: The church dates from the 13th century with 15th century additions and several restorations in the 19th century.

This hollowing tree grows SW of the church. Parts of the outer trunk are missing and two large internal stems and fine aerial roots can be seen. Girth was 13' 7", measured at 3' to avoid the many protrusions. A further three younger male yews grow north east of the church.
