

2004: The male yew grows SSW of the church. Twiggy growth had been clipped close to the bole. There was no obvious sign of hollowing, but a dead section facing the church and large quantities of *Laetiporus Sulphureus* tells us that the process has begun.

The bole divides into thick upright branches from above 10'. There has been a 1' high circular wall around the tree in the past, but this had become hidden on one side as the ground level rises. Girth was 22' 11", a figure swelled by twiggy growth.

Two smaller male yews also grow here, one SW and one NW.
