



The 15<sup>th</sup> century church of St Nicholas is in a raised churchyard with hints of circularity and is thought to have replaced something much older.

No historical records for this tree have been discovered. I visited in March 2006 as a guest of the East Devon Tree Hunt. The male yew now appears as two trunks, the healed halves of a yew which split a considerable time ago. Its girth was 19' 10" at 1'.
