

J.Daryll Evans (1987) recorded 16 yews in *The Churchyard Yews of Gwent*, describing 'more single mature yews than in any other churchyard in Gwent'. That number was unchanged in 2007. The largest is this male growing NW of the church. Rising from a its bole of about 3' (leaning slightly towards the church) are two main branches wrapped around old hollow branches.

Girth: 1987: 650 cm (21' 4") at 1m (Evans)
2000: 19' 11" close to the ground, avoiding roots
2007: 20' 8" at the ground including jutting root
