

8th April 2006: The male yew grows on a slight mound NE of the church. It is a small girthed horse shoe hollow yew with thickening at the entrance and with pieces of the original trunk visible and small internal growth. It divides to 3 main branches at a height of 6'. Girth was 10' 6" at 1' and 11' 1" at 3'.



On the 28th September 2015 girth was 11' 0½" at 1' (above bulge) and 11' 9" at 3'.
