

2001: The yew, growing WSW of the church, was originally a tree of two stems from a low bole, with a 3<sup>rd</sup> section growing outwards rather than upwards between the two.

The tree was damaged in the storm of 1987, although this was not the reason for the destruction of two of its three sections. This, I was told, was necessary because some of their branches hung over nearby graves and this had led to complaints. Girth was 17' 3" at 1'.
