

It is thought by some that this village - 'clearing with yew tree' - was named after the tree.

2000: Low growth on the bole and elder restricted access to this male yew. Its fluted bole breaks into large branches at about 6'. The jumble of rising and angled growth supported thick foliage. There was no sign of hollowing.
