



2006: A church was founded at this site about 750 years ago. Its churchyard is best known as the burial place of the author E.M Delafield, who requested to be 'buried under her favourite yew tree' here. While modern accounts describe 3 ancient yews at this site, this is the only one of great age, a large girthed male growing NE of the church. At the time of the visit ivy had been allowed to swamp much of the tree. Soil level is raised at one end of the yew so that its original base is concealed. Girth was 24' 7" close to the ground.



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
