

1999: This female yew growing SSE of the church seemed in excellent health in spite of fire/smoke damage. At the time of the visit the space beneath its branches was being used as a store for rocks and metal. From the tree's bole of 3' to 4' three major branches develop; a fourth had been sawn off. Girth was 16' 6" at the ground.

The male yew WSW of the church is a thin fragment with growth at each end of the elongated shell and one internal stem. The tree appeared to be almost propped up by elder. Girth was 11' 11" at the ground.
