



2000: A male tree on the east side of the church, close to a steep drop into an adjoining garden.

This has the appearance of a very old tree, with a section of dead sapwood at (A) looking ready to break away. The tree divides into 2 growth areas at about 8/10'.

In *The Churchyard Yews of Gwent* J.Daryll Evans recorded a girth of 495 cm (16' 3") at 1m. The photos are from Geoff Garlick in 2005.
