2005: The church is long gone and hardly any stones remain as evidence. Only a square of pine trees in an otherwise desolate landscape mark the boundary of the churchyard. Yet there has still been provided a parking space and signpost to the site.

The female yew grows NW of where it seems the church formerly stood. Two main branches grow on either side of the old trunk. That on the west side (A) appears to have once been internal growth, meaning that the tree was once much larger girthed than the approximately 14' recorded close to the ground.
