

Llanpumsaint translates as the Parish of five saints. A church is supposed to have been founded here on a pagan site in the 5th/6th century. The yew grows on the north side. I made no attempt to remeasure it and the 570cm (18ft 8in) at the base of the yew and above its roots was recorded by Paolo Bavaresco in 2014. The photographs were taken in March 2015.
