

2013: Of seven yews in this churchyard, the only large one is a male, SE of the church, measuring 16' 6" at the base and 16' 11" at 3'. It gave the impression of a once fine tree, with many large branches and limbs sawn off to encourage upright growth. This is largely carried on a main branch and a second of lesser size. The bole was covered in twiggy and adventitious growth and a hollow was forming.
