A church at Longbridge was recorded in the Domesday survey and it is thought likely that an earlier wattle church stood upon this site.

1998: The circular wall around this female yew has been gradually pushed down by the expanding tree. Its bole separates into 2 main growth areas at about 6'. Many branches, including three large limbs grow around the edge of the tree; many have also been removed. The tree appeared in good health.

Girth

1998: 26' 5" close to the ground - Tim Hills

2012: 26' 11" close to the ground - lower spray has increased on this tree - Peter Norton
