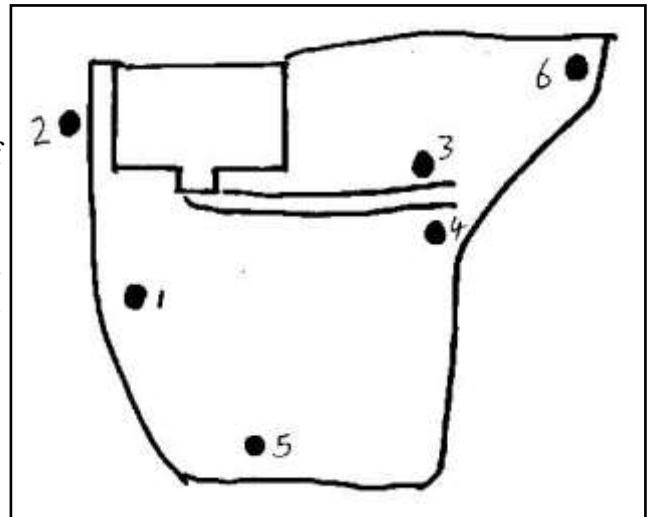


Three noteworthy yews grow amongst mature beech. They are number 3,4 and 6 on this plan.

Trees 3 and 4 grow either side of a path leading to the church. Tree 3, north of the path, had a girth of 278cm at a height of 1.5m, measured over a covering of ivy. It has a suppressed crown form due to the close proximity of tree 4.

Tree 4 is multi-stemmed above a height of about 4m. It had a girth of 292cm at 1.5m, measured over some ivy. It is suppressed on its north side by tree 3.

At the eastern entrance to the churchyard is tree 6, in good condition and with a girth of 259cm at 1.5m. It is suppressed on its west side by beech.
