

1999: A male yew SSW of the church. It was difficult to find anything to examine behind the thick twiggy growth, but there appeared to be a 3/4' high bole which narrows before development of a prominent main branch and several smaller branches. Foliage was thick, as seen in Geoff Garlick's 2005 photo (right).

J.Daryll Evans, in *The Churchyard Yews of Gwent* (1986) recorded a girth of 705 cm (23' 2") at 1m. In spite of the barbed wire and a steep bank down to the adjacent garden, I was able to record a girth of about 21' close to the ground in 1999.
