

2019: The old female yew is found east of the church. It is thought that an early medieval enclosure is associated with this site.

Lowest girth around these fragments and regrowth was 18' 9". At first sight, approaching from the south, this appears to be a windswept younger yew. Further exploration shows that this recent growth is attached to two fragments of a veteran yew. The mound upon which it grows suggests that it was formerly even larger girthed and possibly an ancient yew fragment.
