



The old male yew grows on the north side of the church. It is hollow with internal growth, and divides at 10ft into 2 main growth areas, one thick girthed and rising, the other breaking into many branches and leaning. In 1995 Owen Johnson recorded a girth of 456cm (15' 3") at 0.4m. In 2013 I recorded 15' 4" at 1'. In the church it states that an expert has aged the tree, giving it a planting date of 1650. The tree is considerably older than this.
