The yew was first recorded in 1945, when C.J.O.Evans in *Glamorgan : Its History and Topography* described that 'a very old yew tree stands in the churchyard'.

1998: The male yew grows on a mound. From its short bole are 3 main growth areas, two rising and the third stretching out almost at right angles. All three support considerable branching. Girth was 24' 6" at 1'.
