

2011: The church has a 13th century nave, though parts of the building are thought to be earlier still. The old yew grows SW of and only 4 metres from the building. Although the entire circumference of this yew can be seen, only a small portion still supports growth. Ivy has taken hold in the dead section of the tree, and is so out of control as to be a potential threat to it. The tree appears to have been cut back to a height of about 8ft and many branches of similar size grow from this point on the living portion of this old tree. Girth was 18' 2" close to the ground.
