Cornish's *The Churchyard Yew and Immortality* of 1946 was the first to recognise a yew here, describing it as 'picturesque'.

2004: The yew is male and grows SW of the church. It appears solid, but gaps on its E side close to road show there are large hollow spaces within. Girth is retained for about 20', at which point the tree appears to have been truncated.

Girth 18' 3" at the ground, allowing tape to rise over roots.
