



In 1866 a girth of 20ft was presented to a meeting of the Woolhope Club.

I visited in 1999 and 2013. The tree has a basic hollow horse shoe shape, hidden by the shed. Between my visits the old shed was replaced, with the new one leaving a gap sufficiently large to be able to examine the tree and record an approximate girth measurement of 25' 4". The tape was kept as low as possible, avoiding new basal stems. This appears to be half of the original tree, which must have been vast.
