

2005: The yew tree in front of the church has been given an age of between 2,000 and 4,000 years old. This is clearly nonsense.

It grows close to the church's south porch and had the following girths: 9' at 2', 9' 2" at 4', 9' 6" at 5'. Though there is a complete skin around the tree, a gash from 2' and upwards shows it to be completely hollow. It divides at 6' into 2 main branches which are also hollow.
