Preston on Stour is 4 miles south of Stratford-upon-Avon.

An avenue of 6 yews grow either side of the path leading from the churchyard entrance to the church.

Trees 1, 2 and 3 are on the left, trees 4,5 and 6 are on the right. A 7th yew growing on a bank closer to the church is also recorded.

Tree 1 - male. 1st on the left. 352cm at 30cm measured at the highest point above the bank, keeping tape level.





Tree 2 - female. 2nd on the left. 228cm at 40cm above highest point on the bank.







Tree 3 - male. On the left and closest to the church. Girth 370cm at 40cm above the highest part of the bank.









Tree 4 - male. 1st on the right. 295cm at 40cm from the highest point of the bank






Tree 5 - male. 2nd on the right. 330cm at 40cm from the highest part of the bank






Tree 6 - male. 3rd on the right. 340cm at 40cm from the highest part of the bank. A single dead branch pointing away from the church was noted.





Fourth yew on the right. 335cm at 20cm up from the highest part of the bank and not part of the avenue, though it would appear to be of similar age. The photos show the tree before and after the removal of ivy.
