

2006: Several yews grow at this site, 5 with girths between 12' and 20'. The two largest are female, found at the east end of the church.

The largest girthed, left, measured 20' 7" and consists of two main sections now joined only at ground level. The more substantial tree, right, has had many thick branches removed. A girth of 18' could only be estimated because holly was growing against the trunk.



Close to these living yews is this large yew stump.

Three further yews were recorded as follows:

NNW - 11' 10" at 1'
NE - 14' 8" at 1'
SW - 15' estimated.
