
This painting of Battlefield church after its restoration in 1861/62 shows a yew southeast of the church. It forms part of a collection that is held by Shropshire Archives (258/15787) who have allowed it to be reproduced. Its donor reference is 00012913.

The yew that grows southwest was perhaps not included as it would have obscured the church.





2003: Two female yews grow here. The tree (left) grows SSW of the church. It leans to the south, pulled by the weight of former branches which have now been removed. Girth: 12' 2" at 3'.
