
BUNBURY St Boniface Diocese of Chester SJ569581

The church of is thought to have been founded under the influence of Ethelbald the Mercian king some time after 755AD.

In 1999 I recorded a male yew with an elongated bole and a more recent stem attached at one end for between 6" and 12". This new growth, with a girth of 7' 4", bulges at 3' with twiggy growth.



The tree appeared in excellent condition with a full crown and branches sweeping gracefully to the ground. Girth encompassing the new stem was 19' 6" at 1' and 22' 3" at 3'. Excluding this it is reduced to 15' 2".
