2004: The male yew grows SSW of the church. Twiggy growth had been clipped close to the bole. There was no obvious sign of hollowing, but a dead section facing the church and large quantities of Laetiporus Sulphureus tells us that the process has begun.

The bole divides into thick upright branches from above 10'. There has been a 1' high circular wall around the tree in the past, but this had become hidden on one side as the ground level rises. Girth was 22' 11", a figure swelled by twiggy growth.

Two smaller male yews also grow here, one SW and one NW.
