

FRYERNING

St Mary the Virgin

Fryerning's ancient yew grows west of the church. Girth at 1' above the ground was 559 cm or 18' 4". There was much new growth of small shoots where limbs were cut 20 years ago. There were no recent cuts.



The yew grows 7m east of the church. Girth 440cm at 15cm. The tree has been heavily pruned in the past with major branches being cut off.



The yew grows south of the south porch. Girth was 3m 88cm at 30cm.
