

2004: The female yew grows WSW of the church, on steeply sloping ground at the perimeter of the churchyard. Decayed wood was spilling out of the tree and a portion of stump, which was included in the measurement, will soon be gone, leaving a smaller girthed tree. Of its three main branches only one lives, the others had been cut off at heights of about 6' and 20'. Ivy filled a large part of the tree. Girth was 18' 8" at the ground.
