2013: The yew grows south of the church in a churchyard raised several feet above the level of Church Lane.

Although small girthed, measuring just 11' 5" at 2', this yew is a hollow shell, with a gash on its north side. The hollow closes over at a height of about 8'. At least two internal stems are attached to the inner surface. Above the hollow a central stem rises along with many other branches.
