
2004: The two veteran yews that grow here are both female. This tree, ESE of the church on sloping ground, is decaying on the eastern facing section of its bole. Internal growth was visible as well as much red heartwood. Over thick ivy a girth of 17' 7" was recorded at the ground (or 3' up where ground slopes away). Photos on this page were taken by Shaun Burkey in 2007. He also recorded a girth of 555cm at 10cm.



The yew growing SSE has lost its east face, and lengths of twisted internal growth were visible. It is a low tree spreading outwards rather than upwards. Girth has been larger than the 15' 2" measured around its base on sloping ground in 2004.
