

February 2016: Several yews grow here, the two recorded below on the south side of the churchyard.

This yew grows SW of the church and close to the boundary wall. It is completely hollow and leans considerably. Girth was also recorded as 14' 11" at 1' and 14' 10" at 2' 6".





This yew grows south of the church. Although small girthed, measuring only 8' 9" at 3', this younger yew has half of its trunk missing, revealing internal growth. Many of its branches dip towards the ground. Ivy had been recently removed. Girth was 8' 9" at 3'.
