
The yew, seen here in 1900 and 1998, grows south of the church inside a dry stone slate wall. It has been trimmed to a mushroom shape no more than 15/20' tall. It appeared that its former trunk was cut off at 8'/10' and growth spreads outwards rather than upwards. Girth was approximately 21' at 2' over ivy.
