
Llandyfeisant Church on the Dinefwr Estate was locked and has not been used for some time. I was led to believe that there have been meetings about its future with interested parties do not know the outcome.

I visited in 2002 and recorded three yews. The tree on the left is female and grows close to the edge of an 8' high bank NE of the church. At about 10' a leading branch rises from the edge of its bole. Girth close to the base was about 18'.

The tree on the right is female and grows SSE of the church. At about 15' its internal stem pushes through to the outside of the shell. A large portion of this tree appears to be about to break free, and will leave a horse shoe shape. Girth of a tree that has been larger was 13' 2" at 2'.





A third yew, male, with a girth of just above 14' at its narrowest, grows SSW of the church.
