2000: These linked fragments of a very old yew are found NW of the church. Girth was 24' 6" close to the ground, though two feet of drying grasses prevented precise measurement around the base. There was strong vigorous growth throughout.

In 2005 I recorded 24' 9" close to the ground. The photos by Geoff Garlick in 2008 show that the area around the tree after being cleared.

Smaller yews in the churchyard included a female SW, with an estimated girth of about 14', and a small girthed yew to the SE.
