



2013: SW of church is this leaning male yew filled with dense foliage.

A horse shoe shaped hollow has developed, which grows over at a height of about 15'. Above this are numerous branches, while many had been cut from the south side.



Thin, twisted internal growth was visible in the hollow. The lean makes this difficult to measure at a point where it could be remeasured. A girth of 12' 1" close to the base of the tree can only be a guide.



On the north side is this young yew growing in a hedgerow almost as part of a mixed hedge.
