2003: A 13th century black and white timbered church above the river Vyrnwy. In the churchyard are two male trees, both in fine health. The yew SE of the church has a fluted bole about 6' high supporting many branches and forming a fine spreading crown. Girth at 1' was 11' 7".

The yew north of the church had a girth of 13' 10" at 2'.
