

2004: The oldest yew at this site grows SSE of the church. It is a complex tree with hollowing and some internal growth. One side of the hollow has thickened to support the main branch (A). Next to this a new stem (B) has developed at the edge of the bole and is now itself of substantial size. Girth of 17' 5" at 3' excludes the new stem (B). Including it gives a girth of 22' 4" at 1' 6".
