2007: The fine expansive female tree grows on a small mound south of the church. Its short bole of 4'/5' divides into 8 substantial branches, forming a neat circle of growth around a central platform. Owen Johnson measured the yew in 2005 for the Tree Register's data base as 17' 3" at 1' 6" (526 at 40cm). He considered the tree to be 'perhaps contemporaneous with the one growing in nearby Upton Castle'.
