

In *The Churchyard Yews of Gwent* J.Daryll Evans recorded a girth of 550 cm (18') at 1m in 1986.

2000: Pen-y-clawdd's largest yew is found west of the church. From its bole is a large upright branch, while another grows towards the church. It was ivy clad throughout. I recorded a girth of about 18' at 1'.

In 2016 Peter Norton recorded a girth of 18' 3" at about 2'.

Growing only 2m away, just above the road, is a smaller hollow male tree, and to the SE a 3rd male measuring 12' 8" at the base before bulging outwards. There were a further 5 perimeter yews.
