

An 1870 rebuild of a church dating back to Norman times.

1997 Graham Wilkinson: Three female yews grow here. The significant yew is hollow with a central internal trunk of 2'3" in girth. Measurement of the tree was 13' 8" at base, 14' 3" at 3' and 16' 8" at 4'.

A second yew with a girth of 12' 1" at base is a mature tree with a basal split into four trunks.

A third measured 8' 8" at base and 9' at 3'. It is a large, 'clean' tree, with 4' trunk split.
