There has been a church at this site since Norman times and the female yew grows SE. A girth of 488cm (16ft) at 50 cm was recorded by Owen Johnson in 2013. At the same height I recorded 490cm (16' 1") in 2015, also 16' 3" at 3'. The tree has a fine red fluted bole of about 8' before an outpouring of branches, including a prominent central rising branch. There is one gap into the tree that shows it is beginning to hollow.
