2003: SSE of the church and 10m from the porch is a female yew with large flat tombstones lying on the ground right up to its trunk.

It is completely hollow, the old original trunk can be seen on the side of the tree away from the path, the heart wood in it has decayed and there is one central internal stem (girth of 15") and two others closer to the bole.

Girth:

15' 2" at 1'. 17' 9" at 3' (tree bulges at this height) 16' 10" at 5'


