Taliaris is on the B4302, far from any habitation. There has been a church at this site since medieval times.

2011: The yew grows NW of the church. It is a three stemmed structure that leans towards the church and might one day require a supporting prop. Each of its stems is substantial, 2 with girths of 9' and the third with a girth of 11'. The minimum girth of the whole tree was 18' 8". Many branches have been removed.
